RE: Registration of athletes for 2009 INAS Global Games

Dear Colleagues

As you will know, athlete registration applications must be received by the INAS Secretariat at least 6 weeks before the competition in which the athlete is due to compete.

However, due to the number of athletes who are expected to compete at the 2nd Global Games, it is necessary to impose an earlier deadline.

Therefore, for the purposes of Global Games in 2009, athlete registration applications must be received **NO LATER THAN 10** weeks before the event, which is 9am on April 27th 2009.

You are advised to send applications as early as possible, and you should check carefully that information is complete and accurate, to avoid unnecessary delays.

Applications received later than 9am on April 27th **WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED** and the athlete will **NOT BE ELIGIBLE** for competition at the Global Games. There will be **NO EXCEPTIONS** to this rule.
